

Parcel shelf

Each parcel has a picture on its tag. Write the picture names in order from left to right. Use every listed picture exactly once. There is one solution to each shelf.

01 The five-parcel shelf

Pictures: star, bell, tree, mitten, mug

- The tree is in the middle.
- The star is immediately left of the bell.
- The mug is somewhere right of the tree.
- The mitten is not at either end.

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02 The six-parcel shelf

Pictures: bow, star, mug, bell, tree, mitten

- The bow is at the left end.
- The star is immediately right of the bow.
- The mug is immediately left of the bell.
- The tree is immediately left of the mitten.
- The bell is somewhere left of the tree.

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Work together. Stop when both shelves satisfy every clue; page 2 has the answers.

Check the shelves

A shelf is solved when all its names fit every clue. Read these explanations only when your pair has finished, or if you want a hint.

01 Star / Bell / Tree / Mitten / Mug

The tree occupies place 3. The star and bell must sit together in places 1 and 2: putting them in 4 and 5 leaves no place for the mug to the right of the tree. The mitten cannot be at the end, so it goes in place 4. The mug takes place 5.

02 Bow / Star / Mug / Bell / Tree / Mitten

Bow and star fill places 1 and 2. Mug/bell and tree/mitten each form an adjacent pair. The bell has to come before the tree, so mug/bell take places 3 and 4, and tree/mitten take places 5 and 6.
