Join each beginning to one ending to make a winter or holiday word or phrase. Use each ending once. Draw connecting lines or write the full answers on the right.

The winter words

Read across each row to check the intended pair. A space does not change an answer: gift wrap and ice skate both count.

snow + flake = snowflake

gift + wrap = gift wrap

candle + light = candlelight

ginger + bread = gingerbread

pine + cone = pinecone

fire + place = fireplace

door + step = doorstep

ice + skate = ice skate
