

Caption Match

3-12 players / Print single-sided on US Letter at 100%.

You need: pencils, small scrap-paper slips, scissors.

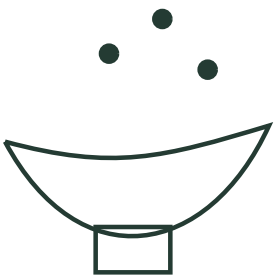
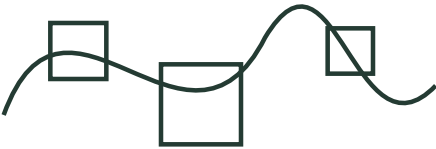
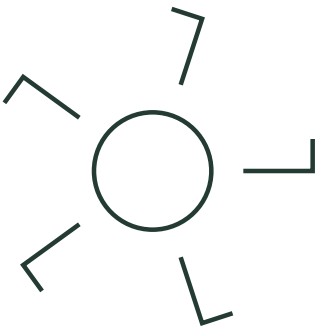
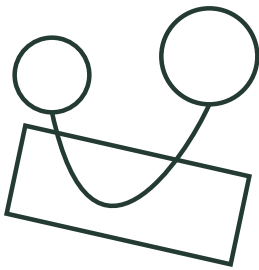
Print both pages once. Keep the six-doodle gallery intact and visible. Cut only the A-F assignment tiles at the bottom of page 2.

- 01** Make 3-6 writers or teams: individuals with 3-6 people, or pairs and trios with 7-12. One person deals but can also write. Shuffle the A-F tiles face down and deal one per player or team; keep unused tiles face down.
- 02** All six doodles stay visible. Each player or team writes a caption of at most eight words for its assigned doodle on the front of a scrap slip, with its initials. Write the assigned letter on the back; keep it hidden. Pass by submitting no slip.
- 03** Use an imaginary scene or title, such as "The moon ordered a trampoline." Do not include the doodle letter or directly name shapes, counts or positions. There is no official caption. Allow about two minutes to write.
- 04** Shuffle the caption slips with captions face up and letters hidden. The dealer numbers their fronts 1, 2, 3 and so on, then reads each aloud. Keep all captions visible. If fewer than two captions were submitted, simply share them and finish without guessing.
- 05** Each player or team privately writes a letter guess beside each caption number except its own. Letters may be guessed more than once. Leave any guess blank to pass. After two minutes, turn over one slip at a time and read its assigned letter.
- 06** The table earns one shared match for each caption that at least one other player or team linked to the assigned doodle. No individual winner or tie. The maximum equals the number of submitted captions. Read other interpretations if people want to share, then stop or redeal for another round.

Make 3-6 pairs or trios, one caption and one guess list per player or team. Seven people make two pairs and one trio.

Six doodles, your captions

Keep the gallery intact and visible. Cut only the six assignment tiles along the bottom.
